















WEB of LIFE - Letter of Support

Web of LIFE introduces a new approach to establishing ecological corridors in **Denmark and Sweden**, with a strong focus on engaging landowners and private companies in a joint effort to restore and reconnect nature.

The project recognises that existing **Natura 2000 areas are insufficient** to support viable populations. To address this, Web of LIFE will create **ecological corridors within and between Natura 2000 areas**, strengthening biodiversity at a larger scale.

Web of LIFE will improve the conservation status of 14 threatened Annex II and IV species across 11 habitat types, spanning five locations in Denmark and Sweden.

Public funding alone cannot solve the biodiversity crisis. Hence, Web of LIFE pioneers a new model where companies co-finance nature restoration as part of meeting their ESG commitments. By linking corporate investment with landowners ready to convert agricultural land to nature, Web of LIFE demonstrates how public-private collaboration can unlock new opportunities for large-scale conservation.

Hylte Municipality is pleased to convey its positive view of, and interest in, the Web of LIFE project. The project's objectives are in line with our local strategies. We are pleased to express our willingness to, where appropriate, assist in communicating the project's objectives and results through our available channels.
